This position maintains a positive relationship with the community and serves as a Public Information Officer. Works under the general supervision and direction of the City Administrator. Supervises all department employees, either directly or indirectly through staff.

Minimum Qualifications: Associate degree in law enforcement, criminal justice or related field. Bachelor's degree preferred but not required. Minimum of five years police experience, of which at least two years is experience as a police supervisor or other police administrative experience. First Responder Certification.
